



Tips on navigating through the **RENOVATE** devotional

We hope this 12-week devotional brings us all closer to God and closer to one another as a community! As this interactive devotional is new to all of us, here's are some pointers and tips as you go through the PDF file.

1. **ADOBE READER**

Before you download the file, be sure you have the latest version of Adobe Reader installed on your computer. There is a link to Adobe on the www.highrockbrookline.org/renovate main page. Mac users - Preview works, but is NOT optimal. To get the full functionality, please view this document in Adobe Reader.

2. **POP UP MESSAGES**

After downloading the PDF (file size = 11.4 MB) and upon opening it, you will encounter a pop-up message like the one on the right:

No worries, just click the "Remember my choice" button and click "Yes" - it'll just open the PDF as a full-screen document.



You'll also encounter pop-ups when you open Media content (videos, .mp3) for the first time. Click "allow" or "yes" - and click the "remember this selection for this document" option. That way, you won't be bothered by these on subsequent viewings.

3. **FULL SCREEN MODE**

If you ever want to get out of full-screen mode, just hit the ESC key on your keyboard. To go back to full-screen mode, just hit **CTRL - L** (PC) or **⌘-L** (Mac).

4. **BASIC NAVIGATION**

For each day of the Devotional, you should first go to the specific Week's page. You can access it by clicking on the appropriate Week Tab along the right side (Week 1, Week 2, etc).

From that page, you'll see the Prayer and the Song for that week. Read and listen to these each day to start your daily devotion. Then, on the top of the Week's main page, you'll see buttons to go to a particular day of the week (see below). Click on it, and it'll take you to that day's readings.



Each day has four sections: a **Scripture Reading**, a **Scripture Reflection**, a **Personal Reflection**, and **Application Questions** to think/write about on your own.

Every Saturday features the Saturday Project, with instructions for that week. You can post Saturday Project items on the Renovate Facebook if you wish to share them w/ the community.

5. **MISCELLANEOUS NOTES**

If you happen to click on anywhere on the page that is NOT a linked object (i.e. the Week tabs), the PDF will advance one page. You can also advance one page (forwards or backwards) by clicking on the arrows on the bottom right corner.
